

Studying the Political Participation of Student Organizations of ShahreKord University Based on Theory of Political

Abstract

One of the most important indexes of development is political participation. This participation indicates how individuals are Obligation to having rights and duties towards society participation of student organizations as one of the groups that plays a major role in shaping, growth and continuity of political development is of special importance. The purpose of this paper is to investigate the relationship between political Obligation and political participation of student - university student formation to show which of the variables of political Obligation can be effective in political participation. The study is based on 188 persons. In the collection of data, Questionnaires whose validity has been measured in the formal method and its reliability has been analyzed by Cronbach's alpha method and the data were analyzed through Spss software. The theoretical framework is composed of the total political Obligation theories of John Horton with three variables (Voluntaristical, Teleological and Deontological) and political participation of Almond and Verba (Official and informal) which indicates the existence of meaningful correlation between the dimensions of political obligation and the degree of political participation of student organization of Shahrekord university.
