

## **Strategies of Imam Sajjad (A) in creating the convergence of Islamic society**

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### **Abstract**

The political and social situation during the time of Imam Sajjad (as) (61-95 AH) was one of the most important periods in the history of early Islam. The period when the Umayyad Caliphate (41-132 AH) and its Marwani branch were at the height of their power. After the martyrdom of their noble father, the Imam took over the leadership of the Shiites. By adopting the policy of harmony of the Islamic Ummah, they were able to save both their lives and the lives of their followers, as well as to remove the sensitivities of the rulers of the Umayyad period.
